In order to be considered eligible for the MEECP field test teachers must agree to:

- Attend a one day summer training held at the MMSA office in Augusta during which they will be introduced to the materials and feedback protocol ("Energy Lights Maine" - Grades 4-5 will be held on Tuesday, August 12, 8 am - 4 pm; "Energy Heats Maine- Grades 6-7 will be held on Tuesday, August 19, 8 am - 4 pm.).
- Field test materials with students in the fall of 2008 and provide feedback.
- Teachers will receive a \$300 stipend for attending the summer one day training and be reimbursed for mileage and meals. Overnight accommodations the evening before the one day training will also be provided if necessary.
- After the fall field test is completed and feedback is submitted, teachers will receive an additional \$500 stipend.
